  - Reference to recent Guardian article on recommended physical exercise
    - Shared Stats
      - Year 10 7% Females, 14% Males
      - Recommended one hour a day DFE Guidance
    - Incentive based exercise discussed
      - $\circ$   $\;$  Could we collate evidence from parents/ carers based on trust / device
      - Caution not all have devices
      - Set a goal for exercise for tutor groups, house
      - Daily or weekly targets to be considered?
  - How can we build in the one mile a day?
  - Inclusivity of PE after school clubs?
    - Are those without the skills but with clear desire included/encouraged?
    - Team selections clearly communicated to students?
  - PE kit
    - Skorts are short and uncomfortable for some students
    - $\circ$  Is there flexibility?
      - How do we facilitate this so there is no unintended consequence?
        - Girls in boys shorts some do as they just prefer them is this made clear to all?
