Collecting Results

If you are unable to collect your results in person, please either:

Send a stamped, self-addressed envelope with the appropriate postage, or leave one at the Student Support Office, for the attention of The Exams Office, St Katherine's School before the end of term. Your results will be sent by post on Thursday 27 August.

<u>Or</u>

Nominate someone to collect the results for you. You must complete the form overleaf and the nominated person should bring it with them (along with their identification) on results day.

Please note: under **no** circumstances will results be available by telephone or email.

This year we will need to ensure that the collection of results can be managed with limited numbers on site at any one time to maintain a safe environment with strict social distancing. We therefore ask that you book into one of the half hour slots available for collection via the Parent's Evening **Booking System.** A maximum 20 students can book into any half hour slot.

Sixth Form

We look forward to welcoming many of you back to the Sixth Form in September.

You must confirm your place by attending a brief interview after you have collected your results. Please do not leave school without confirming your Sixth Form place. If you wish to change courses or reconsider any decisions please discuss this in your admission interview with a member of the Sixth Form team. This meeting should also be booked via the Parents' Evening Booking System you should book a time during or soon after your results collection slot.
