HEADTEACHER'S UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers

So we end the week reflecting on our seven week challenge! This week has been disruptive and a reminder to us all of the importance of adhering to all the safety measures we have put in place. We must all be extra vigilant to help protect us all and thank you to those families who have acted on their vigilance this week.

Reminder: to minimise contact with individuals who are unwell, if you are showing symptoms of coronavirus or have someone in your household who is, you should not be in a childcare setting, school or college. You should be at home, in line with the <u>guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection</u>.

We are encouraging all staff and students to wear reusable face coverings as a sustainable safety measure. We issue reusable masks at Student Support with replacements charged at cost and added to ParentPay (£1.10).

Each week we continue to evaluate our provision and plans and have taken the decision to postpone the Year 11 mock exams due to the ongoing disruption to bubbles and staffing. We were looking forward to launching the 401k Challenge next week with students but this has been postponed this morning - Mr Thomas is determined to set up something to challenge us all and keep us active - more information to follow next week.

On the topic of fitness, it has been great to see so many students across the year groups (on their allocated day!) taking part in the PE extra curricular activities at lunchtime - a huge thank you to the PE department for creating as many opportunities as they can for our young people.
