

This has resulted in three parents being put forward. As this is more than the number of current vacancies on our local governing board, an election will now be held within our parent community. • Who may vote? All parents of (or individuals who have parental responsibility or cares for) pupil(s) registered at school are entitled to vote. • How many votes does each person have? Each person may vote for one person only and can only submit one ballot paper regardless of the number of children they have attending school. • How to vote Online: If you follow this link you will find brief statements written by each of the three candidates and a voting ballot paper. This ballot can only be used once; if there is another family member who is entitled to vote and has not received a ballot paper they should contact the Clerk to the Governors clerk@skdrive.org or telephone 01275 376852 who will be able to issue them a further ballot paper. Completed ballot papers should be returned electronically to school. All votes will be confidential.
