MESSAGE SENT ON BEHALF OF CAROLANN JAMES, INTERIM ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, CHILDREN'S SUPPORT AND SAFEGUARDING

We have only today been made aware of an incident, which occurred on Monday 22 February, which I feel I need to share with you. On Monday 22 February a child, who attends a Portishead School was approached by two men in a black car who stopped and asked them to get in. Thankfully they did not do so and alerted their parents who then contacted the police and the school. Since this time another parent has also reported suspicious behaviour by a male around a local park (which may or may not be related).

It is possible that you will already have received this information, however, I thought it important that you were made aware of it in case you had not, so that you can share where appropriate, perhaps advising parents. If you are aware of any other concerning activity in the local area please can you report to 101.

With all students returning to Learning@School from 15 March we now need to redeploy these devices to enable us to effectively deliver in year group bubbles in school. If your child has borrowed a school Chromebook please ensure that it is returned to the Student Support Office on Monday 15 March and that a receipt for its return is collected.
Mr Francis Black	All years	 All normal school transport will resume from 8 March including St Katherine's services, North Somerset services the X4S with First Bus. Additional St Katherine's services will run on 11 and 12 March for students arriving in school at 12 pm. Please be reminded of the three rules that must be followed on all services: Wear a face covering at all times while on the bus. Sit only in your allocated seat as shown on your bus pass. Remain seated and wear a seat belt at all times
