Whilst we appreciate that students have not had the ideal preparation this year, we feel that students will have received sufficient support to achieve highly. With the current outline for the awarding of GCSEs this summer and with exams not taking place, we will be able to provide a reflective centre assessed grade for students. Whilst we feel that all students will be able to evidence their work effectively, students will have an opportunity to revisit and resit this component at the end of Year 11 if appropriate.
