Dear Parents/Carers

Further to the letter sent to all parents/carers today, we are conscious of the disruption this period of isolation is causing Year 11 at an important time.

To confirm, we are awaiting the outcome of the PCR test. If this PCR test is negative, all close contacts will be able to return to school. We will inform you immediately upon receiving this information which we anticipate will be with us within 24hrs. We ask all students to self test using the LFD tests and report their result as per previous communications.

Should the PCR test for today's reported case be positive, all close contacts will be required to self isolate as per the guidance in the letter sent earlier this afternoon. We will be working with faculties and teachers to ensure no child is disadvantaged through this period of disruption and absence from the classroom. The return to school date is Tuesday 30 March in the event the PCR test is positive.
