Bus Information

We have six bus routes, provided by Turners Coachways and serving all parts of the city. Routes and timetables can be seen [here](#).

Students are allocated a seat number on a designated route which they alone must use and seat belts must be worn throughout the journey.



Payment for buses is collected monthly between September and June, with discounts available for those who are eligible for pupil premium funding or free school meals. Cancellation of places on our buses requires one months notice.

Disciplinary issues on buses are dealt with through a three stage process which ultimately results in the withdrawal of service.
